

Free Application for Federal Student Aid Student Aid Report

Your *Student Aid Report (SAR)* summarizes all the information you provided on your FAFSA. Your SAR will usually contain your Expected Family Contribution (EFC), the number used in determining your eligibility for federal student aid and also the number Ke Ali`i Pauahi Foundation uses to determine financial need. Your EFC will appear in the upper right-hand portion of a paper SAR or an electronic SAR.

Electronic SAR

You will receive your SAR by e-mail within 3-5 days after your FAFSA has been processed, if you provided an e-mail address when you applied. This e-mail will contain a secure link so you can access your SAR online. If you have a “junk” folder or “spam” folder in your e-mail files, check it. The e-mail from FAFSA might be delivered there instead of your inbox.

Paper SAR

You will receive a paper SAR by mail within 7-10 days after your FAFSA has been processed if you do not provide an e-mail address when you apply.
